- To prepare for athletes Tour l'Abitibi (Junior Men).
- To prepare athletes for Tour of Rimouski

3. Winner from Police College Criterium, Steve Bauer Classic, Top 2 from Provincial Championship
4. Coach/Committee selection. Consideration will be placed on the following [in no specific order]:
 - a) Athlete performance at high level competition
 - b) Strengths of the athlete as it relates to the needs of the team
 - c) Athlete racing experience
 - d) Ability to take instruction and work as a team
