Criterion Event Rules

- The races will be held under the rules of the UCI/CCA with OCA modification
- Riders are allowed to enter one race only at this event
- The penalty scale of the CCA rulebook will be applicable
- Registration closes 15 min. before the start of each race
- There is pre-registration available at www.ontariocycling.org (closes May 29th at noon)
- All riders must sign on at registration
- All UCI –licensed riders are eligible to register. OCA Citizen Permit holders under the age of 17 may also register.
- U.S. riders with domestic licenses must purchase a One-Event Racing Permit and are eligible to register in the category listed on their domestic license
- Races will start promptly at the indicated start times
- Licensed commissaries will be officiating
- There will not be a team managers meeting
- No team vehicles will be permitted on the course
- No feeding/handing water bottles during the event
- Any rider dropping out of the race shall immediately notify a commissaire
- Lapped riders may be pulled at the order of the commissaire prior to being overtaken. In no case should lapped riders join an overtaking group.
- There will be one free lap for recognized mishaps. Mishaps include punctures, crashes or a breakage of an essential part of the bicycle only. Riders must report to the wheel pit to obtain the free lap.
 - Riders must supply their own wheels. There is no neutral service. Wheels must have the riders name or team written on an attached piece of paper.
 - There will be no free laps available in the final 5 kms (5 laps)
- All riders within a category will finish on the same lap. If a lapped group is allowed to stay in the race, they will complete fewer laps than the winner.
- Awards will be presented following each race. Top-5 finishers are required to attend the presentations and must wear their competition uniforms.
- The wheel pit will be located near the Start/Finish line. Any incident will be controlled by the Chief Commissaire
 - Chief Commissaire may shorten the race time
 - Unlicensed riders must purchase a \$10 one event permit

Equipment Rules

- Per UCI/CCA rules, only traditional wheels or approved non-traditional wheels are permitted. Consult the list of approved non-traditional wheels at www.uci.ch/english/about/wheels.htm
- Only standard handlebars are permitted. Handlebar extensions including time trial bar extensions are not permitted.
- Only bicycles that fit the UCI definition are permitted. See section 1.3.011 though 1.3.020 of the UCI / CCA regulations.
- Riders are required to wear jerseys corresponding to the club or team printed on their license. Independent and unlicensed riders are required to wear plain-coloured jerseys with no significant logos, team names or advertising on them.
- Sleeveless jerseys are not permitted
- Numbers will be provided by the OCA free of charge. Numbers must be returned at the end of the race.
- Riders are required to wear helmets while racing and while warming up.
- Gear restrictions will be in effect for Junior and Under-17 categories, plus Under-19 Senior 1&2 riders
- The use of glass containers is strictly prohibited during the race

Number Placement

Numbers must be placed on the right shoulder and right hip. Your number must be visible to the camera to get a placing.

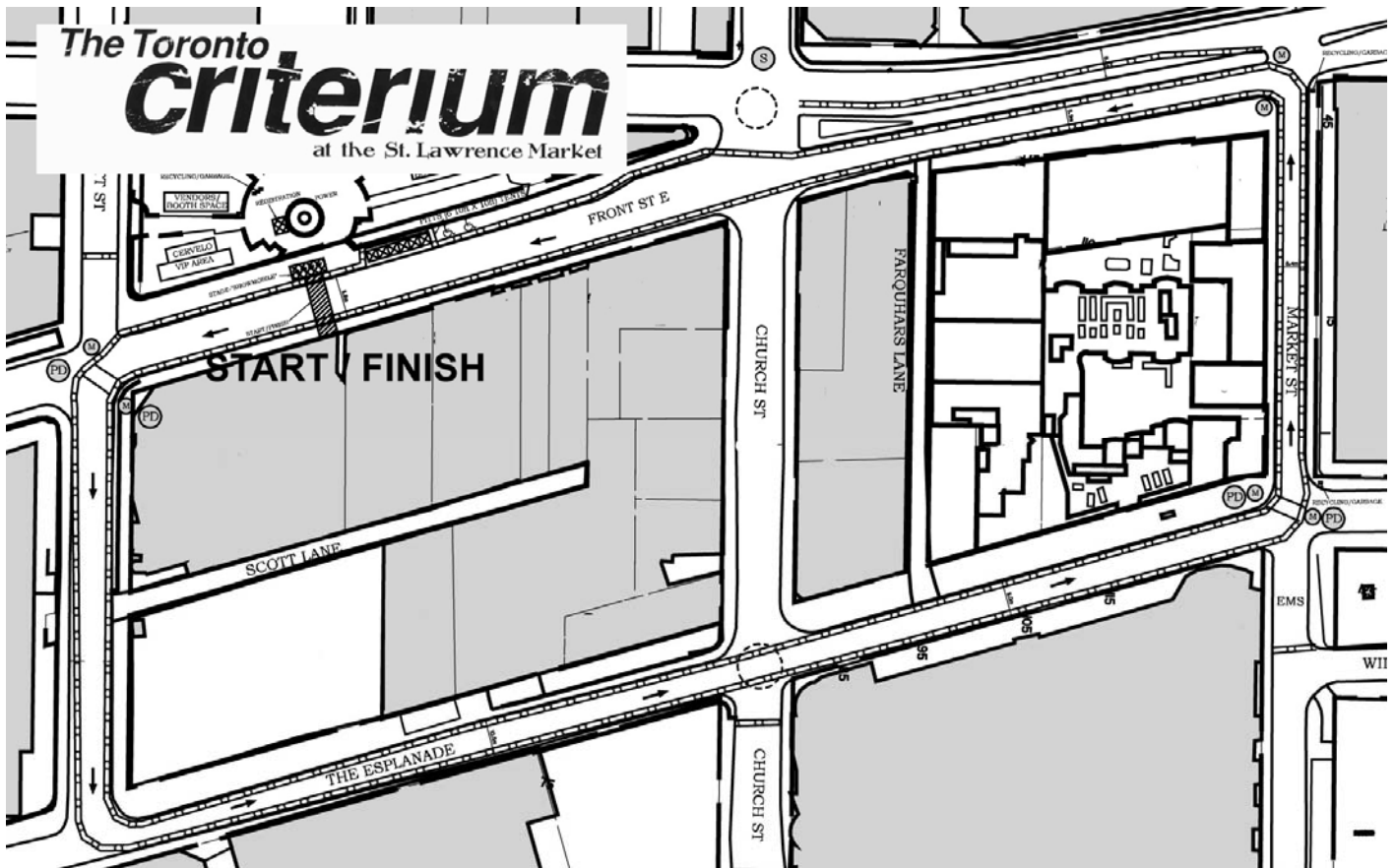
Warming Up

No warming up on the course. Bring rollers if you can, or use an appropriate street nearby. If you have a minimum of equipment, consider riding to the race as part of your warm up.

Course

Start is on Front St. E

Loop goes down Scott St, across the Esplanade, and up Market St. and back to Front. St. E
