Club Try-Out Program

The Ontario Cycling Association (OCA) is pleased to announce that we will be working with clubs to host *Try-Out* opportunities for non-members*. This program will allow clubs to recruit new members without the previous insurance burden. The program is open to all members of the public under the following the procedure:

- Clubs must apply to be part of this program. In this application they must indicate when they will host try out opportunities and be under the supervision of a certified coach**.
- These must be a club sanctioned activity approved by the president.
- Clubs will not be permitted to hold these days outside of the approved dates submitted to the OCA. Clubs will be allowed to have multiple opportunities however these must be forwarded to the OCA at least one week in advance.
- Clubs who are interested in participating in the program should contact the OCA.
- All participants must fill out an OCA waiver and the individual information (found on page 4). Clubs must supply this information to the OCA within 14 days of any Try-Out.
- An individual may only attend a *Try-Out* program ride once.

Insurance waivers must be signed by riders and their parents/guardians (if applicable)

* Previous OCA members cannot take part in the program. These try-out opportunities are not presently available to BMX tracks; BMX clubs should refer to the Open BMX Days program.

**Clubs are expected to provide the appropriate level of the training for the level of the individual who is taking the try-out opportunity.

Any individual or club found to be abusing the program will have their membership with the Ontario Cycling Association revoked.
