

Eligibility for Road Provincial Championships

The Road Provincial Championships and the Championship awards are for racing members of the Ontario Cycling Association. If you are not a racing member of the association, a resident of Ontario and do not hold a licence from another authority, you may race on a one day permit in all categories except Senior 1,2 (Men or Women) or Senior 3 Men, Espoir Men and Master Men 1, 2. You are not eligible to win the Provincial medals on a one day permit. If you currently hold a licence from another jurisdiction you are ineligible to race on a one day permit. Violation of this rule will result in fines and possibly discipline from the authority that issued your licence.

For those members racing on a citizen permit in the U17 categories you do not need a full UCI licence to win the Championship medals.

Fair Play - If you are a former athlete that raced in a high level category i.e. senior 1,2 or Master 1,2 you may not compete in the provincial championship's in a lower category using a one day permit i.e. formerly held a Senior 1 licence – cannot compete on a one day permit in the Senior 4 category or a former M1 cannot compete in M3. Your only option is to purchase a full UCI licence.
